



ZIPPY NECK WRAP

Chunky yarn and big needles make this a quick to knit accessory. The stitch is so much fun that you may be disappointed to be done so fast!

Materials...

100g Misti Alpaca Chunky, 108 yards

#17 needles

Large button, optional

Abbreviations...

sl – slip. [See “Slip Stitch” Video](#)

wyib – with yarn in back.

wyif – with yarn in front.

Instructions...

Cast on 20 stitches. [See “Long Tail Cast On” Video](#)

Row 1 (Right Side). Knit.

Row 2. K1, * sl 2 wyif, return yarn to back, sl the same 2 stitches back to the left hand needle and knit them; repeat from * to last stitch, k1.

Row 3. K1, *p1, sl 1 wyib; repeat from * to last stitch, k1.

Row 4. K1, *sl 1 wyif, k1; repeat from * to last stitch, k1.

Repeat Rows 1- 4 until work measures 26” or desired length.

Bind off using Grandma’s Favorite bind off. [See “Grandma’s Favorite Bind Off” Video](#)

Sew button to center of one short end.

Variations

- Seam short ends together to create a cozy cowl.
- Repeat above pattern until yarn is gone to create a luxuriously long scarf.
