



Classic Cable Napkin Rings

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Turn leftover yarn into a stylish table accessory.

Materials...

Approximately 15 yards of worsted weight yarn makes one napkin ring.
Needle size necessary to achieve a gauge of 5 stitches = 1 inch in stockinette.

- Sample knit with **Simpliworsted** by HiKoo on US #8 needles.

$\frac{3}{4}$ " button

Cable needle

Abbreviations...

C8F – slip next 4 stitches onto cable needle and hold in **front** of work, knit next 4 stitches from left hand needle, then knit 4 stitches from cable needle. **See “Cables” Video**

k2tog – knit two together. **See “k2tog” Video**

yo – yarn over. **See “Yarn Over” Video**

Instructions...

Cast on 10 stitches using German Twisted Cast On. . **See “German Twisted” Video**

Rows 1, 9, 17, 25, 33. (Right Side) K1, C8F, k1.

All even numbered rows 2-32. (Wrong Side) K1, p8, k1.

Row 3. (Buttonhole Row) K4, k2tog, yo, k4.

Rows 5, 7, 11, 13, 15, 19, 21, 23, 27, 29, 31. Knit.

Bind off in pattern. **See “Bind Off in Pattern” Video**

Sew on button.
